Here at your association, September and October are two big months. We have an important Board of Directors Meeting on September 14 (see front page of this Herald). This is where we hear from various committees and receive certain recommendations that will be presented at the Annual Meeting on October 24 (also see front page).

In addition to messengers, guests are always welcome at our Annual Meeting! See you then!
