How did you like February this year? Do you like warm and sunny? You got it. Do you like snow? You got it (for a minute). Do you like rain?... Nah, nobody likes rain in February. West Tennessee may have horrible summer humidity, but we really do have some beautiful weather pretty often.

Now March is upon us, and the official start of spring will soon be here (the 19^{th}) followed by our great celebration of the resurrection of the Lord on the 31^{st} . Let's enjoy these days, rain or shine, as we are blessed with them, for they fly by and are soon gone. As we get a little older, we just don't know how many days we have left to enjoy them (many of us won't even buy green bananas – iykyk).

Moses was the great leader of Israel, but is not really known as a Psalmist. Some believe he wrote a few, but we only know for sure that he wrote Psalm 90. This relationship with the Lord is something to make us glad today, and all our days!
